Rep. Randy Weber Recognized as Courageous Conservative

AUSTIN, TEXAS — Today the Texas Conservative Coalition presented State Representative Randy Weber (R-Pearland) with the Courageous Conservative Award for the 81st Legislature.

State Representative Wayne Christian (R-Center), President of TCC, stated: "A Courageous Conservative works tirelessly to advance and defend conservative principles." Rep. Christian continued: "Based on his spirited defense of conservative values, I am pleased to recognize Representative Weber as a Courageous Conservative."

The Texas Conservative Coalition, the conservative caucus of the Texas Legislature, operates under four guiding LIFT principles: Limited Government; Individual Liberty; Free Enterprise; and, Traditional Values.

Rep. Weber's conservative voting record was top among TCC members, and he had a very successful freshman term in the Texas House of Representatives. Governor Perry signed five bills authored by Rep. Weber, including a bill to protect parking privileges for disabled veterans (House Bill 2020) and a bill to protect the integrity and non-profit status of churches and other religious institutions (House Bill 4103). Rep. Weber also passed a major bill to support and assist victims of human trafficking (House Bill 4009).

Upon receiving the TCC Courageous Conservative Award, Rep. Weber stated: "It has been an absolute honor and pleasure to represent the people of Brazoria and Matagorda Counties in the Texas Legislature. My constituents are hard-working, church-going, honest people who expect principled representation in Austin."

Rep. Weber continued: "The economy, coupled with the fiscal nightmare being experienced in California, called for an especially sharp focus on principles and responsibility in the 81st Legislature. I know that only hard-working Texans, and not the government, will grow the economy and create jobs."

Rep. Christian concluded: "Randy Weber is a Courageous Conservative with a bright future, and we are proud to count him as a member of the Texas Conservative Coalition. We look forward to continuing to work with him to promote and defend conservative principles."

Later this year, members of the Texas Conservative Coalition will make a formal presentation of the TCC Courageous Conservative Award to Rep. Weber at a Town Hall meeting in Pearland. Details will be announced soon.
